Public Notice No. 46, February 2025.

Opening of a simplified selection process for hiring a Brazilian or foreign visiting professor.

The DEAN FOR GRADUATE STUDIES AND RESEARCH AT UNIVERSIDADE FEDERAL DE SÃO PAULO (UNIFESP), in the exercise of its legal and statutory attributions and considering the provisions of Art. 37, Item IX and 207 of the 1988 Brazilian Federal Constitution, Federal Laws no. 8,745, of 12/9/1993; no. 9,394, of 12/20/1996, no. 9,784, of 01/29/1999, no. 12,772, of 12/28/2012, as amended by Law no. 12,863, of 09/24/2013; no. 13,325, of 7/29/2016; no. 13,656, of 4/30/2018; Decree no. 9,739, of 3/28/2019; Item III, Paragraph 5, Art. 4 of Normative Instruction no. 01, of 08/27/2019 of the Ministry of Economy; CONSU Resolution no. 155, of 09/12/2018 (available at https://site.unifesp.br/conselhos/resolucoes), Normative Guidance SRH/MP no. 5, of 10/28/2009, Normative Instruction no. 03 from 2025 of the Pro-rectorate for Graduate Studies and Research (ProPGPq) available at https://www.unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/), and the provisions of this Notice, makes public the opening of registrations to select candidates by the SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS (SSP), to hire a Visiting Professor for a fixed period to meet the temporary need of exceptional public interest under the following conditions and characteristics:

1. PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

- 1.1. The SSP is governed by this Notice and its Annexes available at the electronic address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025, the organization of which will take place in the manner provided for in CONSU Resolution no. 155/2018, Art. 12.
- 1.2 The SSP contemplates the general guidelines of the 2020-2025 Institutional Development Plan and aims to primarily strengthen internationalization, the convergence of knowledge on contemporary themes, new areas, and research issues; the boost to the growth and improvement of research and graduate studies; the encouragement of inter-campus and interdisciplinary initiatives; support for the inseparability between teaching, research, and extension; and the promotion of participation in national and international research networks.
- 1.3 The hired visiting professors must primarily act in internationalizing, innovating, training, teaching, and expanding Graduate Programs and in structuring new areas and relevant and convergent teaching, extension, and research issues. They will have as recommended criteria: high and qualified scientific production; proven training experience; national and international projection and insertion; ability to attract resources; and qualification to support, contribute, and improve activities of relevant academic interest to broadly contribute to the improvement of teaching, research, and extension programs.
- 1.4 The hiring of a visiting professor does not target undergraduate continued teaching. If necessary, it must be justified and analyzed in the context of the Work Plan (see model in Annex IX of this notice).
- 1.5 The vacancy profile developed by each applicant is circumscribed by the following items:
- 1.5.1 Identification of the Proponent: (Campus/University Unit/Department/Program or Center): proponent's data
- 15.2 Identification of the capacity: (Identification in the Unifesp organizational chart): proponent's data
- 1.5.3 Number of offered vacancies: see the opening letter of the notice.
- 1.6 Registration period: 02/25/2025 to 04/17/2025.
- 1.7 **Expected remuneration:** defined based on an equivalence analysis to be carried out by the Commission of Visiting Professors, an advisory body to the Prorectorate of Graduate Studies and Research, observing the ranges of wages of the Career Plan and Positions of Federal Higher Teaching in accordance with Law no. 13,325/2016. (ANNEX I)
- 1.7.1 The remuneration applied will be that in force at the time of hiring.

1.8 Work Regime:

- 1.8.1 40 hours of full-time dedication;
- 1.8.2. 40 hours.
- 1.8.3 **Hiring term:** 12 months, extendable for the same period, provided that the term fails to exceed 24 months in the case of a Brazilian visiting professor or up to 24 months extendable for the same period, provided that the contract fails to exceed 48 months in the case of a foreign visiting professor.
- 1.8.4 The fixed-term employment contract will observe the work regime provided for in item 4 of this Notice, and it is prohibited to change this regime at the time of hiring during the employment contract and/or in the respective extensions.

2 REQUIREMENTS FOR HIRING

2.1 Have been approved in the SSP;

Paragraph 1. The hiring of the visiting professor must be approved by the Graduate and Research Council and made effective by the Pro-rectorate for Personnel Management.

- 2.2 The professional hired as a Visiting Professor must:
- a) Have a PhD degree for at least five years from the date such title was obtained;
- b) be a professor or researcher of recognized experience and competence in their area;
- c) have relevant scientific production, preferably in the last five years. Quantitative and qualitative metrics such as publications of books, book chapters, or articles in journals of excellence with good editorial policy, citations, impact factor, and impact on society are recognized as relevant.
- d) have proven international experience, with a minimum of four months for Brazilian candidates (short-term internships, master's or full PhD or master's or sandwich PhD, post-doctoral research, technical visits, or experience/insertion in an international research network).
- 2.3 PhD diplomas issued by a Brazilian institution must be duly registered. Diplomas issued by foreign universities yet to be recognized and registered by a Brazilian university under the terms of Art. 48 of Law no. 9,394/96 shall be submitted for evaluation of equivalence by a special UNIFESP commission established exclusively for this purpose.
- 2.4 It will be up to this committee to issue an opinion attesting to the validity of the PhD title presented by the candidate;
- 2.4.1 The opinion issued by the committee will be valid exclusively for the hiring resulting from this selection process;
- 2.4.2 The preparation of this opinion will have no cost for the candidate.
- 2.5 Employees of the direct or indirect Administration of the Brazilian Union, States, Federal District, and Municipalities, as well as employees of public companies or mixed-capital companies and their subsidiaries and controlled companies are prohibited to be hired as visiting professors.
- 2.6 Candidates who have worked as substitute or visiting professors may not be hired again before 24 months have elapsed since their previous contract, based on Law no. 8,745/93.
- 2.7 The retired teacher, regardless of the work regime carried out in activity, may be hired for a fixed term under the terms of the legislation in force.
- 2.8 It is forbidden for retired UNIFESP professors to participate in this notice.
- 2.9 The prohibition of paid accumulation of public positions and jobs provided for by Art. 37, XVI, of the Federal Constitution of 1988, is applicable.
- 2.10 The selected candidate must show physical and mental aptitude, attested by the Official Medical Board of UNIFESP, to exercise the duties of the position.
- 2.11 The selected foreign candidate must present their Permanent Visa at the time of hiring.
- 2.12 The qualified foreign candidate who is in national territory and has no Permanent Visa must apply for a work permit with the **Pro-rectorate for People Management at UNIFESP**, which will submit an application for a residence permit for the nominated candidate to the Ministry of Justice and Public Security or Equivalent Body via the Labor Immigration Portal (Migranteweb) under the terms of Art. 3 of CNI Normative Resolution no. 24, of 2/20/2018 c.c. Art.143 of Decree no. 9,199, of 11/20/2017, as soon as the official publication of the result of the Public Tender is made.
- 2.13 The nomination of apt foreign candidates who are in national territory and have no Permanent Visa will depend on the authorization of the previous item.
- 2.13.1 The allocation of Visiting Professors will occur in the Departments indicated by the applicants for the vacancies.
- 2.14 Brazilian candidates must be up to date with their electoral obligations.
- 2.15 Brazilian male candidates must be up to date with their military obligations.

3 APPEALS TO THE PUBLIC NOTICE

3.1 Any citizen may appeal this notice or any amendments to this notice on a reasoned basis by filing, via the email address profvisitante@unifesp.br or, if they so preferred, in person or by proxy at the UNIFESP Protocol Sector, at Rua Sena Madureira n° 1.500 - Ground Floor - Vila Clementino - São Paulo/SP, from Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., except on holidays and three-day weekends, within two business days after its publication.

If the appeal is made by an attorney-in-fact, a simple proxy of attorney must be presented without the need for notarization and accompanied by a simple copy of the appealing document and a simple copy of the attorney-in-fact's identification document, who must present their original documents for validation.

- 3.2 The signature on the proxy of attorney must be the same as the one on the copy of the document of the appealer, presented by the attorney-in-fact at the time of the challenge.
- 3.3 Requests for objections shall be judged by the ProPGPq in conjunction with the Graduate Program or Unit requesting the SSP.
- 3.4 The appealer must necessarily indicate the item/sub-item that will be challenged and its legal basis.
- 3.5 The responses to the appeals will be made available in a single file at the electronic address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025 in up to two days of the end of the period for appeal.
- 3.6 An administrative appeal will be filed against the decision rejecting the challenge on behalf of the Dean of Graduate Studies and Research at Unifesp.
- 3.6.1 The appeal shall be addressed to the authority that issued the decision, which, failing to reconsider it within five days, shall forward it to the Highest Director of the Body.
- 3.6.2 The administrative appeal against a challenge to the Public Tender Protocol will have no suspensive effect.

5 PROCEDURES FOR REGISTRATION

- 5.1 It is forbidden to register in more than one vacancy in this notice.
- 5.2 The following documents are requirements for registration:
- a) simple copy of proof of PhD degree or equivalent (diploma, certificate of completion, or a document issued by the Pro-rectorate for Graduate Studies that proves the PhD degree);
- b) simple copy of the identification document with photo (Identity Card, National Identity Card, Work or Class Bodies, Passport, or National Migration Registration Card);
- c) scanned copy of the Application for Registration in the form of ANNEX II of this Notice, completed and signed (which may be include an electronic signature) and addressed to ProPGPq, available at the address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025.
- d) curriculum vitae for foreign applicants (according to the model in ANNEX III) and CV Lattes for Brazilian candidates.
- e) document proving international experience (diplomas, certificates, declaration of the international collaborator);
- f) work plan, with a maximum of 10 pages, correlated, referenced, and contextualized to contemporary trends in the intended area/subarea and to the Institutional Development Project of UNIFESP, which can be consulted at the electronic address: https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025;
- g) letter of intent to work (detailing motivations, interests, and objectives in line with the institution and the sought area);
- h) for foreigners, self-declaration of proficiency in one of three languages: Portuguese, English, or Spanish; and
- i) foreign applicants must submit documents in English or Spanish.
- 5.3 Registration will be exclusively made electronically at the address https://prof-visitante.siiu.unifesp.br/login-participante in the period from 02/25/2025 to 04/17/2025 by the following procedures:
- a) Fill out the registration form available at https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025.
- b) Send the documents by the proper registration form listed in Item 5.2 by scanning them in PDF format with their respective identifications in a maximum size of 10 MB. In each item of the form, the proofing documents must be attached in a single file. During the registration period, the form can be accessed to update data and send documents.
- 5.3.1 Registrations that fail to comply with the specifications in Items 5.2 and 5.3 will be refused;
- 5.3.2 UNIFESP will send the confirmation of receipt of the registration data to the electronic address informed by the candidate in the form provided for in the Item 5.3;
- 5.4 If duplicate registration is found in the same Notice for the same candidate, the most recent one will be considered, disregarding the previous ones;
- 5.5 UNIFESP bears no responsibility for registration requests not received due to technical reasons, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, and other factors that make it impossible to transfer data.
- 5.6 Under no circumstances will conditional or extemporaneous registration be made.
- 5.7 Submission of documents after the deadline or by other channels not provided for in this notice will be rejected.
- 5.8 The candidate who fails to send the documents requested herein will be eliminated from the simplified selection process.

^{***} Recognized Competence - Recognition in an area of competence must prioritize: a) Articles published in journals of excellence and/or books published in publishers nationally or internationally recognized in the academic environment; b) Post-doctoral research; c) Associate professorship; and d) Management activities. The elements above should be used as guides. Given the specificities of the areas of knowledge, some may be discarded in the analysis of candidates if they are difficult to obtain by candidates.

- 5.9 The candidate is responsible for the information provided, and the non-veracity of this will eliminate them from the simplified selection process.
- 5.10 Registrations may be extended due to practical and/or operational needs at the discretion of Universidade Federal de São Paulo, and it is sufficient, for all legal purposes, it available at the following electronic address: https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025.

6 ENTRIES

6.1 UNIFESP will offer 80 VP vacancies in the following thematic areas:

- a) Humanities, Arts, and Communications;
- b) Life Sciences;
- c) Exact Sciences and Technologies;
- d) Environment, Management, and Sustainability;
- e) Applied Social Sciences;
- f) Interdisciplinary, Multidisciplinary.
- 6.2 The list of available vacancies can be found in ANNEX IV of this notice.
- 6.3 If the vacancy fails to be filled, it will be reopened.
- 6.4 Under no interest from any applicant in item 6.2 of this Notice, the vacancy will return to ProPGPq for a new draft.
- 6.5 Applicants for vacancies will indicate the capacity of the hired Visiting Professor: Academic Department for Graduate Programs, and Rectory or Pro-Rectories for Centers, Chairs, Institutes, Agencies, and Secretariats.

7 RESERVATION OF VACANCIES

- 7.1 Under the terms of this Notice, the reservation of vacancies for candidates living with disabilities or Black applicants are in compliance with Law no. 12,990/2014.
- 7.2 The distribution of vacancies reserved for Black or Brown candidates and those living with disabilities in the areas/sub-areas of knowledge offering vacancies will take place after the final result of the public tender via classification in a single list of candidates who opted for the reserved vacancies, therefore only focusing on the areas of knowledge with approved applicants living with disabilities and/or Black candidates.
- 7.3 Vacancies reserved for Black or Brown people and those living with disabilities will be occupied primarily by approved Black or Brown candidates with disabilities who ranked better.
- 7.4 To distribute the reserved vacancies, a list will be made with Black or Brown candidates and those living with disabilities, reclassifying them into a single list in descending order of their final grade regardless of their chosen area/sub-area of knowledge to ensure that the number of reserved vacancies provided for by law is met as a priority.
- 7.5 If more than one candidate from the same area/sub-area of knowledge between the approved candidates opted for the reserved vacancy, the one with the highest final score among will be included in the list.
- 7.6 In the event of a tie in scores between candidates on the single list of reserved vacancies, the tiebreaker will follow the provisions of items 11.2.5 of this notice.

8. REGISTRATION FOR BLACK OR BROWN CANDIDATES

- 8.1 In total, 20% of all vacancies will be reserved for Black or Brown candidates, as per ANNEX IV of this notice, and those that may arise during the validity period of the simplified selection process, pursuant to Law no. 12,990/2014.
- 8.1.1 If the application of the percentage in item 8.1 results in a fractional number, it will be increased to the first subsequent integer in case of a fraction equal to or greater than 0.5 or decreased to the next lower integer in case of a fraction below 0.5, pursuant to Paragraph 2 of article 1 of Law no. 12,990/2014.
- 8.2 The form of occupation of the reserved vacancies will be as described in item 7.4 (Distribution of Reserved Vacancies).
- 8.3 Candidates who self-declare themselves Black or Brown will indicate in a specific field whether they wish to choose to compete via the vacancy reservation system at the time of registration.
- 8.4 The information provided at the time of registration is the sole responsibility of the candidate, who must answer for any falsehood.
- 8.5 To compete for the reserved vacancies, candidates must choose to compete for the vacancies reserved for Black or Brown candidates at the time of registration, filling out the self-declaration that they identify as Black or Brown (ANNEX VII), according to the color or race requirement in the Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics.
- 8.6 All areas/subareas of knowledge in item 6.1 of this notice will be available for registration in reserved vacancies provided that the candidates opt to self-declare as Black or Brown in the form.
- 8.7 The self-declaration will be valid only for the Simplified Selection Process for which they registered.
- 8.8 The information provided by candidates at the time of registration will be presumed to be true, without prejudice to the determination of administrative, civil, and criminal responsibilities.
- 8.9 A list containing the candidates who chose to compete for the vacancies reserved for Black or Brown candidates will be published at the electronic address

in item 1.1.

- 8.10 Candidates may request a change in their option to apply for vacancies for Black and Brown candidates within two business days after the publication date in item 8.9.
- 8.10.1 For the expected submission of the request provided for in item 8.10, candidates must send their request via the electronic address profvisitante@unifesp.br.
- 8.11. Black or Brown candidates will concomitantly compete for the vacancies reserved for them and for those intended for wide competition, according to their order of classification in the public tender.
- 8.12. Black or Brown candidates who are approved within the number of vacancies offered to the broad competition will be ignored in the calculation to fill the vacancies reserved for Black or Brown candidates.
- 8.12.1 In case of approval in both classification lists for the area/sub-area for which they applied, being nominated in one of them, candidates will be excluded from the other lists in which they appear and the vacancy will be filled by the candidate in the following classification in that respective list.
- 8.13. In case of withdrawal of a Black or Brown candidate approved in a reserved vacancy, it will be filled by the approved Black or Brown candidate ranked immediately after the one who withdrew in the area/sub-area for which they applied. In case of no qualified candidates on the list of Black and Brown people, the vacancy will be reverted to wide competition.
- 8.14. The vacancies in **ANNEX IV** that remain to be filled either due to a lack of Black or Brown candidates, public tender reproval, or after assessment by the hetero-identification commission will be reverted to the broad competition once the specific list has been exhausted to be filled by other approved candidates in strict compliance with candidates' ranking order.
- 8.15. The vacancies reserved for Black or Brown candidates may be occupied by candidates from the broad competition in the event of no approved Black or Brown candidates.
- 8.16. The appointment of approved candidates will respect the criteria of alternation and proportionality, which consider the ratio between the total number of vacancies and the reserve of Black or Brown candidates.
- 8.17. Candidates registered as Black or Brown will participate in the SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS on equal terms with other candidates regarding the evaluation and approval criteria and the score required for all other candidates.
- 8.18 In case of no registrations in the public notice under the reserved vacancies for Black or Brown people or those living with disabilities, they will be immediately transferred to wide competition.

9. COMPLEMENTARY HETERO-IDENTIFICATION PROCEDURE TO THE SELF-DECLARATION OF BLACK OR BROWN CANDIDATES

- 9.1 Candidates approved in the public tender who self-declared Black or Brown will be subjected, before the approval of the result in the public tender, to the hetero-identification procedure complementary to the self-declaration of Black or Brown candidates, as provided for in Normative Ordinance no. 23, of 07/25/2023, of the Ministry of Management and Innovation of Public Services.
- 9.2 To assess the veracity of the information provided by the candidates, the Heteroidentification Commission will only observe physical aspects (phenotypes). Ancestry, family ties, cultural or religious characteristics, and past records or documents (including image and certificates referring to confirmation in heteroidentification carried out in federal, state, district, and municipal public tenders) will undergo no analysis.
- 9.3 The date, time, and place for the assessment by the commission will be published on https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025. Candidates must monitor the information.
- 9.4.1 The call referred to in the caput of this article will be published at the electronic address in item 1.1 at least five business days before the date of verification.
- 9.4.2 People who choose to compete for vacancies reserved for Black or Brown people, even if having obtained a sufficient score for approval in the broad competition and meeting the approval conditions in the public notice, must undergo the hetero-identification procedure.
- 9.5 The candidate will be considered to not be Black for the purpose of reserving vacancies if the Commission considers, by majority vote, their non-compliance with the color or race requirement by the candidate, according to item 9.2.
- 9.5.1 The candidate will be eliminated from the public tender:
- $a)\ if\ they\ fail\ to\ attend\ the\ hetero-identification\ procedure\ complementary\ to\ the\ self-declaration,\ according\ to\ item\ 9.1;$
- b) if they refuse to be filmed during the hetero-identification procedure complementary to the self-declaration, according to item 9.6;
- c) if the Committee considers, by majority vote, the non-compliance with the color or race requirement by the candidate according to item 9.2.
- 9.5.2 The candidate fails to attend the hetero-identification procedure complementary to the self-declaration for any reason will be unable to reschedule this stage of the public tender.
- 9.6 The hetero-identification procedure will be filmed and recorded for possible appeal analyses.
- 9.7 Candidates unconfirmed in the hetero-identification procedure will compete for vacancies intended for wide competition.
- 9.8 The opinion of the hetero-identification committee that finds the falsity of the self-declaration must motivate its conclusion under the terms of art. 50 of Law no. 9,784, of January 29, 1999.
- 9.9 The hypotheses in the previous items give rise to no duty to call additional uncalled candidates for the hetero-identification procedure.
- 9.10 After the committee's decision, an appeal will be made to the Hetero-Identification Appeal Committee within two business days from the publication of the result on the website described in item 1.1, the initial term of which referring to the first day following the date of said publication.
- 9.10.1 The appeal must only be filed by the electronic address http://concursos.unifesp.br/, and will be judged in a maximum period of 15 business days.

- 9.11 The Hetero-identification Commission will be composed of five members and their alternates who will have their resumes disclosed. Moreover, its members must be distributed by gender, color, and, preferably, place of birth.
- 9.12 The resumes of the members of the hetero-identification commission will be made available at the electronic address http://concursos.unifesp.br on the day of publication of the call notice for this phase.
- 9.13 The hetero-identification committee will deliberate by the majority of its members in the form of a motivated opinion.
- 9.14 The deliberations of the hetero-identification committee will be valid only for this contest.
- 9.15 It is forbidden for the hetero-identification committee to deliberate in the presence of the candidates.
- 9.16 The content of the motivated opinion will be of restricted access under the terms of Art. 31, Law no. 12.527, of 11/18/2011.
- 9.17 The candidate who makes a false statement will be eliminated from the public tender.
- 9.18 In the event of a false declaration, the candidate will be eliminated from the Simplified Selection Process for hiring a Visiting Professor and, if appointed, will be subjected to the annulment of their admission to public service or employment after an administrative procedure, for which they will be assured of the adversarial procedure and full defense without prejudice to other applicable sanctions.
- 9.19 The resumes of the members of the appeals committee, which will be composed of three members of the hetero-identification committee, will be made available at the electronic address http://concursos.unifesp.br.
- 9.20 If the decision fails to confirm self-declaration, candidates will have the opportunity to appeal it.
- 9.21 The appeal will be judged within a maximum period of 15 business days, and the analysis period may be extended for the same period upon explicit justification.
- 9.22 Any other form of appeal other than that in item 13.2 will be disregarded, and forwarding via fax or e-mail will neither be considered nor will an extemporaneous appeal be judged.
- 9.23 In its decisions, the appeals committee must consider the filming of the procedure for hetero-identification, the opinion issued by the committee and the content of the appeal prepared by the candidate.
- 9.24 The decisions of the appeals committee shall be subject to no appeal.
- 9.25 Other information regarding the hetero-identification procedure will be contained in a specific call notice for this phase.
- 9.26 UNIFESP is exempt from travel and accommodation expenses of the candidates summoned by the Commission referred to in this item.
- 9.27 The evaluation of the specific Commission as to the fit of candidates as Black persons will be valid only for the public tender to which they have registered.
- 9.28 The non-classification of the candidate as a Black person fails to constitute a discriminatory act of any nature.
- 9.29 Under no specific vacancy for the Black or Brown candidate, qualified candidates will be approved within the limit provided for in the current legislation, cases that include no right to appointment. This can only occur when vacancies arise, and a sufficient quantity is reached for the reservation of vacancies.
- 9.30 In the event of a false declaration, the candidate will be eliminated from the simplified selection process for hiring a Visiting Professor and, if hired, will be subject to the annulment of their admission to the service after the administrative procedure in which they will be assured of the contradictory and full defense without prejudice to other applicable sanctions.

10. REGISTRATION OF PEOPLE LIVING WITH DISABILITIES

- 10.1 Overall, 20% of the total number of vacancies will be reserved, as indicated in **ANNEX IV**, and the vacancies that may arise during the validity period of this notice.
- 10.2 All areas/subareas of knowledge in item 6.1 will be available for registration for reserved vacancies provided that candidates indicate their condition in the registration form.
- 10.3 Vacancies reserved for people living with disabilities may be occupied by candidates without disabilities if no candidates living with disabilities receive approval.
- 10.4. To compete for vacancies reserved for people living with disabilities, candidates must, at the time of registration, declare themselves as living with a disability and send an original medical report, issued in the previous 12 months, which must be written in legible letters and provide for the type and degree or level of disability, with express reference to the corresponding code of the International Classification of Diseases, citation of the candidate's name, stamp indicating the name, CRM number and signature of the physician responsible for its issuance, to the Official Medical Board of the Workers' Health Care Center/DSTra/Unifesp, and the possible cause of the disability.
- 10.5 The original medical report will be valid only for the public tender in which it is registered.
- 10.6 The medical examinations of candidates who declare themselves to live with a disability will be carried out in due course.
- 10.7 The rejection of the application to compete as a candidate with a disability will be subject to appeal within two business days from the publication of the result on the website profvisitante@unifesp.br, having as its initial term the first day following the date of said publication.
- 10.8 The appeal must only be sent to the electronic address profvisitante@unifesp.br, being judged for a maximum period of 15 business days.
- 10.8.1 The candidate who fails to file an appeal within the mentioned period will be responsible for the consequences arising from their omission.
- 10.9 The candidate who fails to deliver such medical report will be excluded from the list reserved for people living with disabilities, competing only on the list of broad competition according to their classification.
- 10.10 Candidates who choose to compete for vacancies reserved for people with disabilities will concomitantly compete for the vacancies intended for broad

competition and those reserved for Black people if they meet this condition and following their classification in the public tender.

- 10.10.1. Candidates approved as people living with disabilities and appointed within the number of vacancies offered to the broad competition will be prohibited to fill the vacancies reserved for people with disabilities.
- 10.10.1.1 In case of appearing as qualified in both classification lists for the area/sub-area to which they applied and nominated in one of them, the candidate will be excluded from the other lists in which they appear and the vacancy will be filled by the candidate subsequently classified in the respective list.
- 10.11. If a candidate living with disabilities is approved, appointed to a reserved vacancy, and fails to take office in the position, the vacancy will be filled by the candidate living with disabilities who is subsequently classified for the area/sub-area for which they applied. In case of no qualified candidates on the list of people living with disabilities, the vacancy will be reverted to wide competition.
- 10.11.1. If approved candidates with disabilities fail to fill the reserved vacancies, the remaining ones will be reverted to wide competition to be filled by the other approved candidates, observing the order of classification in the competition.
- 10.12. The appointment of the approved candidates will respect the criteria of alternation and proportionality, which consider the ratio between the total number of vacancies and the number of vacancies reserved for candidates living with disabilities and Black candidates, observing the provisions of Annex IV regarding the occupation of vacancies with priority reservation.

11. OF THE SIMPLIFIED SELECTION PROCESS (SSP)

- 11.1 The SSP will consist of the following assessments:
- a) classificatory analysis of the work plan;
- b) qualifying analysis of the curriculum vitae for foreign applicants and CV Lattes for Brazilian candidates.
- 11.2 The analysis of the work plan, curriculum vitae, or candidates' Lattes curricula will consider and score:

- 11.2.1 A grade will be assigned from zero to 10, with up to two decimal places, in the analysis of the work plan, curriculum vitae, or Lattes curricula, according to relevance and insertion in the areas of knowledge and in the special teaching, research, or extension program to be served by this selection process, respecting the maximum score in the Item 11.2.
- 11.2.2. The reference framework above assigns the weights to be observed in the two evaluated dimensions: analysis of the professional and scientific trajectory and the proposal of the work plan to be developed.

EVALUATION FRAMEWORK

- 11.2.3 The analysis of the work plan will consider the following:
- a) quality, regularity, and adequacy of scientific production to the Work Plan;
- b) experience in research lines related to the areas described in the Work Plan;
- c) coherence and adequacy of the candidate's training to the objectives, activities, and goals in the Work Plan;
- d) feasibility of the Work Plan within the term of the contract.
- d.1 Candidates' work plans must consider the strategic objectives of the action, internationalization, pedagogical projects, the convergence of knowledge in contemporary themes and new areas of research, the intercampi and/or interdisciplinary dimensions, and the activities to be developed.
- d.2 The work plan must be presented, according to the model of ANNEX III of this Notice.
- 11.2.4 Candidates who obtain the minimum score of seven will be considered qualified in the analysis of the work plan, curriculum vitae, and Lattes curricula.
- 11.2.5 Classification will fall under the descending order of the final grades awarded to the qualified candidates;
- 11.2.6 In the event of a tie in the minimum final weighted average, preference will be given to the candidate who successively has:

- a) the highest score in the Work Plan;
- b) older age;
- c) curriculum analysis.
- 11.2.7 If the tie persists after the application of the criteria in Item 11.2.5, the Selection Committee will proceed to break such tie by a draw.
- 11.2.8 The preliminary result of the classification of candidates will be published on the electronic address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025, according to the schedule in ANNEX VI.

12 OF THE SSP SELECTION COMMITTEE

- 12.1 The Selection Committee will consist of three evaluators chosen by the ProPGPq Visiting Professor Committee, observing the indications made by the proponents of the vacancy in this Notice.
- 12.2 Candidates will be evaluated in a remote manner by a Selection Committee composed of three professors from the area or, in their absence, from a related area, which will analyze candidates' curricula, accompanied by the documents presented at the time of registration that were described in item 5.2 of this notice.
- 12.2.1 For Graduate Programs, it is recommended that among the evaluators the participation of the PPG Coordinator or their deputy and, if impossible, the Coordinator of the Graduate and Research Chamber of the University Unit. The names must be approved and included in the minutes of the CEPGs or Council of the established body of the applicant for the vacancy.
- 12.3 The Selection Committee will enter the evaluation scores in the Score Table provided by UNIFESP, observing the scoring criteria provided for in Item 11.2 of this Notice.
- 12.4 Anyone who, regarding any candidate, is a blood relative or related to said candidate in a direct or collateral line up to the third degree shall be prohibited from participating in the Selection Committee or its presidency, which will also occur for anyone who is or has been a stepchild, spouse, or partner; partner with direct business interests; advisor or co-advisor in master's theses, PhD theses, advisor in postdoctoral research or vice versa; or regular collaborator in research activities or publications.
- 12.5 The composition of the Selection Committee will be disclosed to the candidates at the electronic address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/propgpq/propgpq/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025.

13. APPEALS

- 13.1 An appeal against the provisional result of the SSP will be admitted.
- 13.2 The appeal, addressed to the Presidency of the Selection Committee of the area/subarea, should be sent to the email address profvisitante@unifesp.br, or, if preferred, in person or by proxy at the Protocol Sector of UNIFESP, at Rua Sena Madureira, 1500 Ground floor, from Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., except on holidays and three-day weekends, within five business days after the publication of the provisional result on the ProPGPq website, having as its initial term the first day following the date of said publication.

If the appeal is made by an attorney-in-fact, a simple proxy of attorney must be presented, without the need for notarization, and accompanied by a simple copy of the appealing document and a simple copy of the attorney-in-fact's identification document, who must present their original documents for validation.

- 13.2.1 The signature on the proxy of attorney must be the same as the one on the copy of the document of the appealer, presented by the attorney-in-fact at the time of the appeal.
- 13.3 The appeal will be analyzed within a maximum period of seven business days without any suspensive effect on the SSP process. The period of analysis may be extended for an equal period upon explicit justification.
- 13.4 Received electronically, the appeal will be forwarded to the Chairmanship of the Selection Committee of the Area/Sub-area in item 4 of this Notice, who will deliberate with the members of the Commission to rectify or maintain the result.
- 13.5 UNIFESP will not be responsible for appeal requests not received due to technical reasons, communication failures, congestion of communication lines, and other factors that make it impossible to transfer data.
- 13.6 The candidate must be clear, consistent, and objective in their claim.
- 13.7 Appeals filed by fax, telegram, or means other than those specified in this Notice will be rejected.
- 13.8 The Selection Committee is the last instance for appeal, being sovereign in its decisions, which is why no additional appeals will be allowed.
- 13.9 Appeals will be rejected if:
- a) the content disrespects the Selection Committee;
- b) they disagree with the specifications in this Chapter;
- c) they are without reasoning, with inconsistent or incoherent bases, or outside the deadlines;

- 15.2 In the event of an extension pursuant to the item 14.1, the new deadline will be published on the ProPGPq website.
- 15.3 The validity period of the selection process will equal one year from the date of publication of the Notice of Approval of the Final Result, and may be extended at most, for an equal period, at the discretion of the Administration.
- 15.4 The visiting professor contract will be for a fixed period in a work regime established in the Item 4 of this Notice, observing the following maximum deadlines:
- a) Brazilian Visiting Professor: one year, which may be extended, at the discretion of the applicant for the vacancy, provided that the term fails to exceed two years:
- b) Foreign visiting professor: two years, which may be extended, at the discretion of the applicant for the vacancy, provided that the term fails to exceed four years;
- 15.5 The performance of the visiting professor at UNIFESP must be subordinated to the approved Work Plan and to the Internal Regulations of the Graduate Program, when necessary.
- 15.6 Subject to the legal limits, visiting professors hired by this Notice will have attributions resembling those of the UNIFESP permanent staff, in accordance with Art. 1 of CONSU Resolution no. 155/2018.
- 15.7 Visiting professors may receive no assignments, functions, or charges outside their contract nor may they be nominated or be appointed, even if on a precarious basis or as a substitute, to exercise a position on commission.
- 15.8 The candidate who wishes to view the SSP or extract copies may request it by the Request for Views of the Process, when applicable.
- 15.9 For the purposes of the deadlines mentioned in this Notice, the Brasília time will be observed.
- 15.10 CONSU Resolution no. 155/2018, ProPGPq Normative Instruction no. 03, of 2025 or another that replaces it constitutes an integral part of this Notice, of which the candidate, when registering for the selection process, declares to be aware.
- 15.11 It is the candidates' sole responsibility to keep their physical and electronic addresses updated, as well as their telephone numbers during the term of this SSP.
- 15.12 Candidates may make registration updates by the electronic address profvisitante@unifesp.br.
- 15.13 In case of disciplinary infractions attributed to the hired visiting professors, they will be investigated by an inquiry, concluded within 30 days, that ensures defendants' full defense.
- 15.14 The time of service provided by visiting professors will be counted for all legal purposes.
- 15.15 This Notice is regulated by its clauses, the precepts of public law, and the internal rules of UNIFESP.
- 15.16 Omitted cases will be resolved by the ProPGPq.
- 15.17 This Notice is also available in Portugues and Spanish, or in other languages that may be necessary, on the ProPGPq website at the address https://unifesp.br/reitoria/propgpq/professor-visitante/editais-pss-2025. It should be noted that, in case of divergence between the versions of the Notice in foreign languages and Portuguese, the version of the Notice in Portuguese will prevail.
